Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It is that time of year again...time to organize, mobilize and start spreading the word to every union local in Ontario about Operation Christmas Cheer's 8th annual Labour of Love campaign!

Operation Christmas Cheer's only mandate is to deliver grass roots support, cheer, food hampers, grocery gift cards (so a family can purchase a traditional Christmas dinner) and toys to Ontario picket-lines during the Holiday Season. Every year our mission is the same, help as many union families as possible!

We have way too many of our Brothers and Sisters who are facing the harsh reality of being on the picket-line during the Holidays. They are struggling to make ends meet with little hope of returning to work before Christmas!

Employers listed below are refusing to bargain or bargaining in bad faith. Job security, seniority, safety, working conditions, fair wages, benefits and pensions across the province, are under attack by greedy corporate agendas coast-to-coast.

On behalf of **6 Ontario locals and 507 of our Brothers and Sisters on strike/lockout**, Operation Christmas Cheer is respectfully asking your local/union/committee/council or region to **take action and help us cheer on these locals in hardship** this Holiday Season;

1. **United Steelworkers - USW 1-1000 – Pembroke:** 40 members on strike against Commonwealth since April 2009 –**30 MONTHS – 129 WEEKS.**
2. **United Steelworkers – USW 526 – Toronto:** 47 members on strike against Infinity Rubber since December 2009 –**22 MONTHS – 94 WEEKS.**
3. **United Steelworkers – USW 13571– Toronto:** 140 members on strike against Alumicor since March 2011 – **8 MONTHS – 34 WEEKS.**
4. **Communications, Energy and Paper Workers of Canada – CEP 87M – Toronto:** 130 members have been on strike since September 21, 2011. This was their 1st contract negotiations after becoming unionized – **6 WEEKS.**
5. **United Steelworkers – USW 9597 – Ottawa:** 15 members on strike against Inkas since October 3, 2011 – **4 WEEKS.**
6. **Ontario Public Service Employees Union – OPSEU 334 – Peterborough:** 130 members on strike against Kawartha-Haliburton Children's Aid Society since October 19 – **3 WEEKS.**

Any other local that is locked out or goes on strike before Christmas...will be added to our list. Every dollar, non-perishable food and toy collected by OCC goes directly into the hands of our Brothers and Sisters on strike/lockout within our communities. All monetary contributions collected are used to purchase grocery gift cards (from unionized grocery stores) for active union families collecting strike pay during the holidays. OCC will deliver Labours Christmas Cheer on the dates and times listed below.
